BONNIE BERG

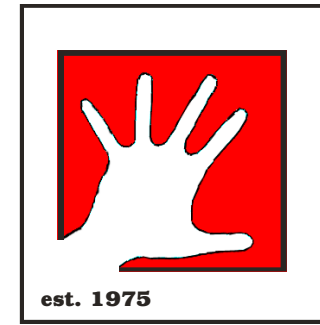
